BYLAW 4 MEMBERSHIP

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MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

- 5.1. Membership of the Angling Confederation is open to all National Federations and National Associations who are the sole representatives of their angling and casting sport's code in South Africa, and who are willing to comply with the Angling Confederation's constitutional stipulations, endorse and support SASCOC and DSAC policies and priorities.
- 5.2. Member Federations and Member Associations must as far as possible, adhere to any program of development and transformation as laid down by SASCOC and DSAC.
- 5.3. The Confederation must be affiliated to the respective International Angling Controlling Bodies. The Member Federations and Member Associations will thus through SASACC, inter alia have membership to the International Angling Controlling Bodies.
- 5.4. Member Federations and Member Associations Constitutions shall not be in conflict with the Angling Confederation, SASCOC, DSAC and their International Federation's Constitutions.
- 5.5. Member Federations and Member Associations must adhere to the requirements as stipulated in the National Sports Act 110 of 1998 as amended from time to time.

- 5.6. The members of the Confederation consists of the following:

- 5.10. South African Casting and Surf Casting Federation (SACSCF)

ACCEPTANCE OF NEW MEMBERSHIP

- 5.11. The application of new membership to the Confederation will be on an application basis.
- 5.12. The application will be tabled at a Confederation Annual General Meeting for acceptance of membership.
- 5.13. A new applicant must submit the following as part of the application:
 - 5.13.1. Constitution and all By-Laws/Annexures.
 - 5.13.2. National Council members' personal and contact detail.
 - 5.13.3. Membership list of all members with members' personal and contact detail.
 - 5.13.4. List of Provincial Association.
 - 5.13.5. Proof of paid capitation fees paid to the Confederation.
- 5.14. No new membership will be awarded should there be an existing member with membership in a specific angling discipline. The disciplines are subdivided in the three International Angling Controlling Bodies, namely FIPS Mer, FIPS Ed and FIPS Mouche.

ENDING OF MEMBERSHIP

- 5.15. The membership to the Confederation can be ended by means of a decision by the National Council of the Member Federation's and Member Association's during Annual General Meeting.
- 5.16. The membership of a Member Federation and Member Association can be suspended or cancelled in line with the clauses contained in the constitution of the Confederation.
- 5.17. The membership of a Member Federation and Member Association can be suspended or cancelled should the Member not adhere to the requirements stipulated in the National Sports Act 110 dated 1998 as amended from time to time.
